

# Finnish Open Optimist Championships 2012

Organising authority: Esbo Segelförening r.f (ESF) Regatta location: Amiraalinsatama, Espoo Date: August 2nd-5th, 2012

## NOTICE OF RACE

#### 1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS) and the Finnish Optimist Dinghy Association's regulation for Finnish Championship in Optimist. There will be racing for less experienced sailors in the Cadet Race.
- 1.2 No national authority prescriptions will apply.
- 1.3 The Appendix P of RRS will apply.
- 1.4 Rule 61.1(a)(2) is amended with the following addition: Immediately after finishing the protesting boat is required to inform the race committee about the intention to protest and of the identity of the protestee.
- 1.5. Rule G3 applies under special permission by the race committee.
- 1.6 If there is a conflict between languages the Finnish text will take precedence.

#### 2 ADVERTISING

2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

#### 3 ELIGIBILITY

All competitors must be born year 1997 or later. Sailors born 2002 or later are recommended to participate in the Optimist Cadet Race.

### **4 ENTRIES**

- 4.1 Entries shall be made not later than July 20<sup>th</sup>. Entries are made on entry forms for the event available on the website www.esbosegelforening.f.
- 4.2 Late entries may be accepted until August 1st at 1700 hrs and with 50% raised entry fee.
- 4.3 A boat is considered to have entered to the competition after the entry form has been sent and the entry fee has been paid.
- 4.4. The payment shall be made not later than July 23rd to bank account:

#### **6 REGISTRATION**

Registration and measurement inspection at Amiraalinsatama August 2<sup>nd</sup> between 11.00-20.00. Registration for the Cadet Race from August 2<sup>nd</sup> at 11.00 to August 4<sup>th</sup> at 10.00.

#### 7 SCHEDULE

Saturday August 4<sup>th</sup>: 3-4 Races, first warning at 09.55 Sunday August 5<sup>th</sup>: 3-4 Races, first warning at 09.55.

3-4 Races, first warning at 09.55. No warning signals are given later than

15.55.

The Championship Program consists of maximum 9 races.

Cadet Race Program:

Saturday August 4<sup>th</sup>: Racing 11.30-16.00 Sunday August 5<sup>th</sup>: Racing 10.30-15.00

The Cadet Program consists of maximum 6 races.

## 8 MEASUREMENT AND EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

8.1 The measurement inspection is performed at a dedicated measurement station in Amiraalinsatama as scheduled in 6. above. Addditionally the boat or the equipment may be inspected by random checks at any time during the regatta.

- 8.2 Each boat shall at the measurement station present:
- a valid Class Measurement Certificate.
- a confirmation of third party liability insurance.
- the sail loose from the rig for inspection measurement
- 8.3 Each sailor must have a named person on a coach/support boat responsible for the safety of the sailor both on water and on land.
- 8.4 8.1-8.4 Does not apply to Cadet Race.

### 9 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available at registration at the Race Office. The Sailing Instructions will be available also on the web site www.esbosegelforening.fion August 2nd.

## 10 VENUE

10.1 Regatta harbor is the ESF club harbor at Amiraalinsatama, Espoo.

10.2. The location of the harbors and the racing areas are shown on the website www.esbosegelforening.fi

#### 11 SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats s shall register at the Race Office and provide a list of sailors they are responsible for.

#### 12 BERTHING

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places in the boat park. Boats participating in the Cade Race can be kept at Paven in Pentala.

#### 13 PRIZES

Medals will be given to finnish sailors according the rules for finnish championships. Regatta prizes will be given as well.

## 14 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4 (RRS). The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

### 15 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.
